Silvina Montrul received her PhD from McGill University in 1998. is Professor of Linguistics and Spanish, Italian and Portuguese, as well as Second Language Acquisition at the University of Illinois at Urbana Champaign. She specializes in second language acquisition, bilingualism, psycholinguistics and heritage language acquisition. Her research focused on adult second language acquisition of syntax and morphology. She published books on incomplete acquisition of language and heritage speakers, as well as the acquisition of Spanish. She has been named University Scholar for University of Illinois in 2013 and is co-chief editor of the *Second Language Research*.
